

How to do 15 generation ALC pedigree research on Bengals using BengalPedigrees.com

Go to Bengal Pedigrees and pull up a black three generation pedigree on the cat you want to research. Click on the link for a printer friendly 5 generation pedigree. In the address bar of your browser find the portion of the URL that says "print5.php" and change it to "print15.php" and pull up the new web page which will be a fifteen generation pedigree. You can also use "print10.php" to pull up a ten generation pedigree if you prefer. Save the new web page to your hard drive to make it faster to do the next phase of the search process. Close your browser and open the saved file in your browser.

Now to start the actual search process, hold the Ctrl key down and press F at the same time to open a Find box. Here is the search parameter I use in the find box to start; " - ALC -", this gives me a count of the number of times that an ALC appears in the pedigree. Here is a list of some of the more common ALCs in pedigrees that you can search for.

As you research make a note of the total count of each ALC you find like this:

SNOPRIDE UNEXPECTED FROST

I also look for the number of times a Bristol shows up in the database by searching for "BRISTOL M" which appears to be the source of some of the amazing donut shaped patterns we are seeing these days.

BRISTOL M - 30 Occurrences

I don't count ALC parents of ALCs that I find in the pedigree. ALC Pretty Lady of New Horizon is the only ALC that produced F1 Bengals and ALC kittens (to the SBT level) in the Bengal Pedigrees data at this time. Their presence however does contribute to the total number of ALCs in the 15 generation pedigree.

Once I have the total count of ALCs I figure the closest generation to each ALC in the pedigree and note it as well.

BONZAI - 24 Occurrences - F13
STONEY - 1 Occurrences - F15
BRISTOL M - 30 Occurrences - F10

This gives me a snapshot of the diversity of ALC genetics in a given cat. SnoPride Unexpected Frost has 8 ALCs behind her within 15 generations.
